



Reminder: AIG American General Transitions to Electronic Commission Statements

AIG American General's last commission statement mailing will be March 28, 2008. On December 3, 2007, AIG American General began the transition to electronic-only commission statements. **March 28, 2008 marks the next significant step in our transition: All agents will be required to obtain their commission statements electronically by visiting your AIG American General secured Web site:**

- ▶ www.aig-iag.com (if you are contracted with the Independent Agency Group)
- ▶ www.aiglifebrokers.com (if you are contracted with AIG Life Brokerage)

Following are the key items to remember for the payroll of **April 4, 2008, and going forward:**

- ▶ Agents who receive their commissions via Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) will no longer receive either a commission statement or an EFT stub in the mail. All commission statements can be obtained via the Web site.
 - ▼ Agents on EFT will continue to be paid at their current frequency.
- ▶ Agents who receive their commissions via check will receive only their check in the mail. Commission statements will be available on the Web site.
 - ▼ Agents receiving their commissions via check will be paid bi-weekly.
- ▶ Agents registered for the Web site will be able to print multiple statements at the same time with the new batch print functionality, available on the Web site as of March 3, 2008.
- ▶ Agents registered for the Web site will be able to view a breakdown of their commissions via the Commissions Pay Summary. An automatic e-mail notification will be sent to the e-mail address in "My Account" when new commission statements are available to view.

Interested in moving to weekly pay? Please submit a completed Direct Deposit Authorization form together with a voided check today. Use form **AGLC100316 REV0806** if you are contracted with the Independent Agency Group or form **L1341** if you are contracted with AIG Life Brokerage.
