RE: Updated Replacement Forms for Accident and Sickness Insurance Products

A recent audit of our Accident and Sickness Insurance Replacement Forms indicated there were changes needed in order for our forms to be in compliance with the individual state regulations. The process for reviewing and updating replacement forms for each state has been completed. As part of the update, all replacement forms now have a barcode located in the bottom right hand corner of the page.

Effective immediately, the updated forms are being included with the application packets. All of the updated forms are also available on the Extranet. If you currently have a supply of application packets that include replacement forms, you will need to replace the old forms. If you do not have access to the Extranet for ordering forms, please follow your normal procedure for obtaining forms.

As of June 1, 2006 the old Accident and Sickness replacement forms will no longer be accepted. Business submitted on and after that date will need to include the updated replacement forms before the policy can be issued. You can verify that you are using the updated forms by the barcode.

The following states have specific Accident and Sickness Replacement Regulations and require the use of replacement forms when replacing an Accident and Sickness policy. Regulations can vary by state on the types of policies that require replacement forms, if you have any questions, please refer to the state specific regulation or contact the Assurity Life Insurance Company underwriting department for assistance.
